

INDIVIDUAL SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

Camper Scholarship: Scholarships are intended to fund ¼ of the registration fee for children, youth and adults to attend a Presbyterian sponsored or supported camp. Funds are made available through the Presbytery's Operations Budget.

Applications are available by March and should be completed by April 15.

Scholarships are paid directly to the camp and have ranged from \$35-\$110 for individuals and \$95-\$300 for families. The total amount budgeted is approximately \$3,000 annually.

Funds are administered by the Resource and Program Coordinating Team.

Synod School Scholarship: Scholarships are intended to assist individuals and families cover the expense of attending Synod School. Funds are made available through the Presbytery's Operations Budget.

Funds are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Applications are available by March and should be completed no later than June 1.

Scholarships are paid directly to the Synod in the amounts of \$100 for individuals, \$180 for couples, and \$220 for families of 3 or more. The total amount budgeted is \$3,000 annually.

Funds are administered by the Resource and Program Coordinating Team.

Seminary Scholarship: Scholarships are intended to provide financial aid for theological students under care of Winnebago Presbytery who demonstrate a need. Funds are made available through the Academic Debt Reduction Grant Fund.

Applications are made available to Candidates and Inquirers in March and should be completed by June 1 for the upcoming academic year.

Individual Scholarships (Continued)

Scholarships are usually in the amount of \$1,000.

Funds are administered by the Committee on Preparation for Ministry.

Seminary Debt Reduction Grants: First call pastors earning less than the church-wide median salary may be eligible for an Academic Debt Reduction Grant.

CONGREGATIONAL GRANTS AVAILABLE

Genesis - New Ministry Grant: Sessions/congregations may apply for a one, two or three-year grant to help fund a program or project to promote new ministry and growth within the congregation. Funds are made available from a portion of the earnings of the Genesis Fund.

Applications are made available by March and should be completed by May 31.

Grants are recommended to Presbytery for approval in September and will be distributed annually in December. Grants have ranged from \$1,000 - \$5,000 per year. Total amount available is dependent on investment earnings.

Funds are administered by the Grants Allocation Committee.

Small Church Grant: Sessions/congregations of small membership churches (100 or less) may apply for funds in order to:

- * meet emergency capital or property needs when other resources are not available.
- * fund no more than 50% of capital or property projects to enhance or expand the mission of the congregation in ways congruent with the mission of the Presbytery.
- * provide no more than 50% support for program costs for projects designed to enhance or expand the mission of the church in ways congruent with the mission of the Presbytery.

Applications are available and may be submitted when a need arises.

Grants normally do not exceed \$5,000. Funds are made available through the 90% of the earnings from the investment of the Small Church Endowment Fund.

Funds are administered by the Grants Allocation Committee.

Congregational Grants (Continued)

Local Mission Grant: Sessions (individually or jointly) may apply on behalf of a particular mission, ministry or project in the church or community. Entities may apply for start-up funds (not more than 3 years, normally decreasing amounts); one-time requests; or annual operating support. Projects must be re-validated each year. Funds are made available through the Operations Budget.

Applications are made available by March and should be completed by May 31.

Grants will be recommended to Presbytery for approval when the next year's budget is approved, normally by November. Funds will be distributed the following year on a quarterly basis in March, June, September and December.

Grants range from \$1,000 - \$8,000 per year. The total amount available is at least 10% of the projected Operations Income Budget for the coming year.

Funds are administered by the Grants Allocation Committee.

Emerging Need Mission Grant: Sessions (individually or jointly) may apply on behalf of a particular mission, ministry or project in the church or community. They may be one-time, start-up or on-going operating. Funds are made available through the Operations Budget.

Applications are made available by March 1 and may be submitted at any time during the year for a project or ministry that develops outside the cycle for Local Mission Grants.

Grants range from \$500 - \$5,000. The total amount available in a given year is 1% of the Operations Income Budget.

Funds are administered by the Grants Allocation Committee.
