

DEPENDENT CARE POLICY
Presbytery of Winnebago
Adopted November 11, 2000

This policy is intended only for those who would be prevented from attending presbytery events because of a need for dependent care when there is no family member to assist or if the dependent is not in a regular day care setting. Reimbursement is not intended for family members or to supplement regular day care costs.

Committee Meetings

In instances where elected members of committees, subcommittees, or task groups are responsible for adult dependents or children under the age of fourteen and where there is no family to care for the dependent without charge or when the dependent is not already in a regular day care setting, the elected members may include in vouchered expenses for the meeting the cost of such dependent care at a rate of \$3.00 per hour/dependent to assist in the cost of dependent care.

Persons whose dependent(s) is/are in regular day care may voucher for any extended hours of day care if the hours are the result of meeting attendance.

THERE IS NO DEPENDENT CARE REIMBURSEMENT FOR THOSE WHO BRING DEPENDENTS TO COMMITTEE MEETINGS.

Presbytery Meetings

DEPENDENT CARE WILL NOT BE OFFERED at Presbytery meetings. Ministers and elected commissioners who are responsible for adult dependents or children under the age of fourteen and where there is no family to care for the dependent or where the dependent is not in a regular day care setting, may include in vouchered expenses for the meeting the cost of such dependent care at a rate of \$3.00 per hour/per dependent to assist with expenses.

Persons whose dependent(s) is/are in regular day care may voucher for any extended hours of care if the hours are the result of meeting attendance.

THERE IS NO DEPENDENT CARE REIMBURSEMENT FOR THOSE WHO BRING DEPENDENTS TO COMMITTEE MEETINGS.
