

Camp Is Almost HERE!



The planning team has been working hard and we are excited about the upcoming camp. Here are some things you need to know to prepare for our time together.

Camp begins on **Thursday, Oct 27, 2011**

Plan to arrive at camp after dinner on **Thursday, around 6 p.m.** – a map is included in this mailing. **When you arrive please come to the Memorial Building**

Each day we will have small group sessions, recreation, free time and worship. (see attached schedule)

As in the past, we will have a nurse available to us during the event. Prescription medications need to be housed in the health lodge. Campers will be free to go the health lodge as needed.

Camp ends on **Sunday, OCT 30, 2011 at 1:00 p.m.**

Things you need to bring

- Weather appropriate clothing – it will be COLD at night and cool during the day
- Sleeping bag, pillow, linens (VERY HELPFUL TO BRING AN EXTRA FLAT SHEET to place between the mattress and the squeaky springs to keep the noise level down)
- Towel and personal toiletries (soap/shampoo/tooth paste etc...)
- Flashlight
- Snacks to share
- Bible
- Quarters for the soda machine
- A musical instrument if you'd like to play in worship
- Games (board games, footballs, etc...) to share
- Medications (must be listed on registration form and in original bottle with name and dose information)
- A list of allergies and any health concerns
- A hammer (PLEASE LABEL with you name)
- Safety glasses
- Work gloves
- A thumb drive to copy pictures at the end of the event (other options will be available)

Things you may NOT bring

- PDAs, personal CD players, IPODs, Gameboys or any other personal electronic devices. Cell phones may be used only in case of emergency.
- Firearms or any weapon
- Drugs, alcohol, cigarettes

Directions from Milwaukee:

Take I-794 W towards I-43/I-94. Merge onto I-94 W via Exit 1A toward Madison. Merge onto US-45 N via Exit 305B towards Fond du Lac. Take US-41 N toward Fond du Lac. Take the US-45 N Exit – Exit 120 – toward Fremont/Waupaca. Turn left onto US-45 N / Algoma Blvd. Continue to follow US-45 N. Turn slight left to take the US-10 W / US-45 N ramp towards Stevens Point / New London. Merge onto US-10 W. Turn right onto WI-161. Turn left onto County Road A.

Directions from Madison:

Take I-39 N/I-90 W/I-94 W towards Wisconsin Dells. Take the WI-78 S/I-39 N exit – Exit 108B – towards US-51 / Portage / Wausau. Take the WI-66 exit – Exit 159 – toward Stevens Point/Rosholt. Turn right onto WI-66 N. Turn left onto County Road A.

Directions from Eau Claire:

Take WI-29 E toward Wausau. Merge onto US-51 S/WI-29 E toward Green Bay/Stevens Point. Merge onto WI-29 E via exit 187 toward Green Bay. Turn right onto WI-49. Turn right onto Saumer Rd. E. Turn left onto County Road A.

Directions from Green Bay:

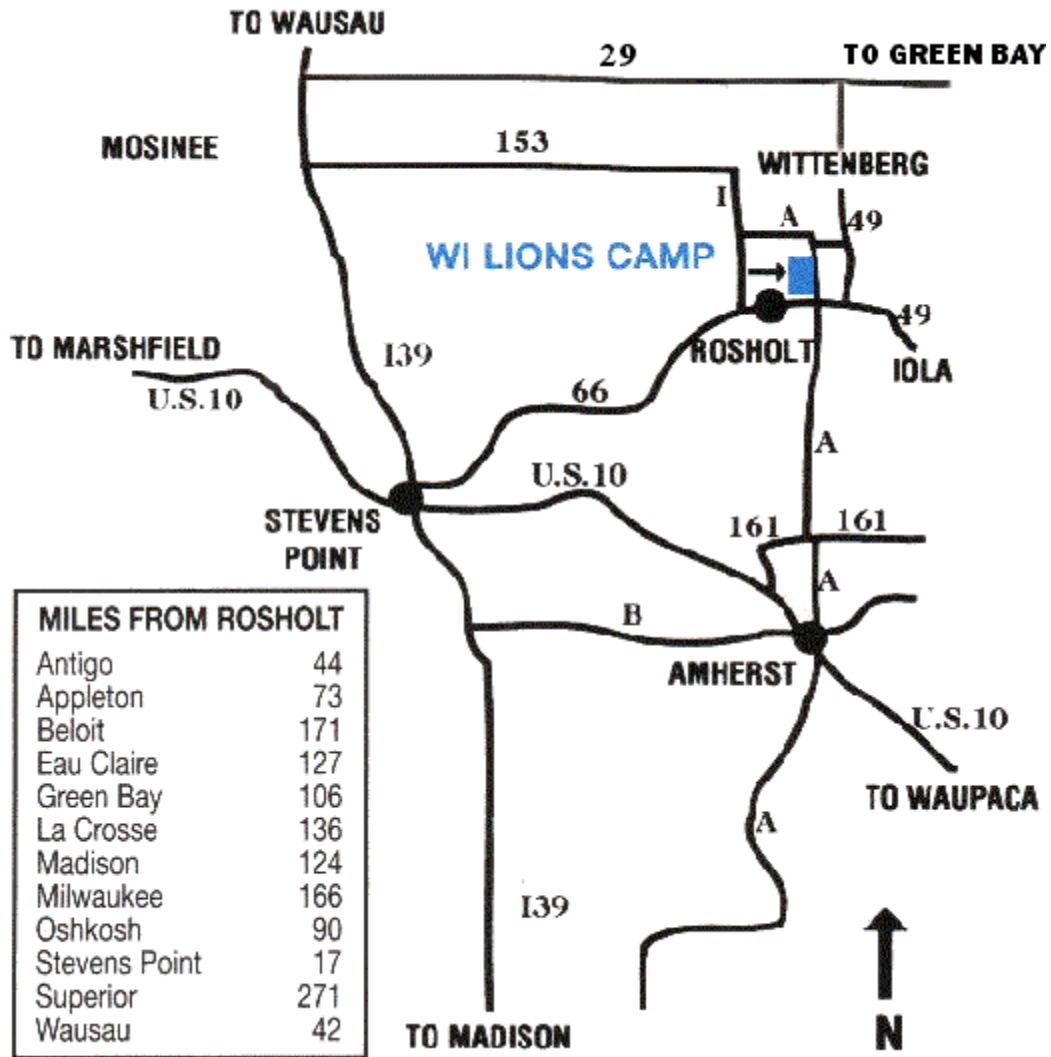
Take WI-29 W toward Wausau. Turn left onto WI-49. Turn right onto Saumer Rd. E. Turn left onto County Road A.

Directions from Wausau:

Take US-51 S/WI-29 E. Merge onto WI-29 E via Exit 187 toward Green Bay. Turn right onto WI-49. Turn right onto Saumer Rd. E. Turn left onto County Road A.
